CERTIFICATION:**

1. Bachelor's degree and 10,000 hours of related welding work experience, 6,000 of which occurred within the last five years, or

Associate degree in welding content area or 60 semester hours of related work experience within the last five years, or

10,000 hours of related work experience, 6,000 of which occurred within the last five years preferred.

2. Related work experience must include cutting, brazing, and welding a variety of metals in vertical, horizontal, and overhead positions.
3. Related work experience with oxyacetylene, shielded metal arc gas, metal inert gas, and tungsten inert gas welding methods is also necessary.
